Part V - Other Florida Registered Covers with Examiner Markings

Collecting registered mail is an area deserving of more research. I have only touched the surface of what is available in Florida. This is Part V of the five-part census: Part I – Early Statehood Covers 1845-1857, Part II – Florida Towns with Registered Mail 1858-1911, Part III – Florida Registry Exchange Labels 1883-1911, and Part IV – Florida Towns with New York and San Francisco Registry Exchange Labels.

The "letter" type examiner markings were in service for 19 years at the New York, General Post Office, Registry Division. They were part of their internal check on incoming registered mail to ensure they were properly sealed, before processing them for delivery to their final destination (domestic or foreign). They went through many design changes along with adding additional letters to cover for new employees. Some of the processing marks unique to these post offices may have been assigned to specific work stations within the registry division. There were smaller nine letter alphabetic handstamps used between 1884 and 1902: “**B, C, D, E, H, L, O, S, and U.**”¹

The decades after 1857 saw more registered covers as more Florida post offices were established. Russell and Evelyn Ryle’s book *Registered U.S.A. – The Handling of Valuable First-Class Mail by the U.S.P.O. Rates, Markings, Delivery Restrictions, and Processing Procedures* would be a good starting point to review the types of handstamps that were available.

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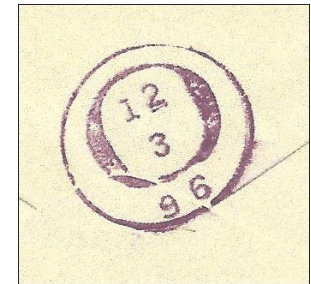

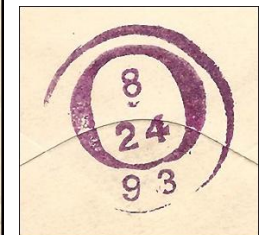


Chattahoochee Fla. 04.10.1890, on reverse examiner's handstamp C. (Courtesy of Deane Briggs)

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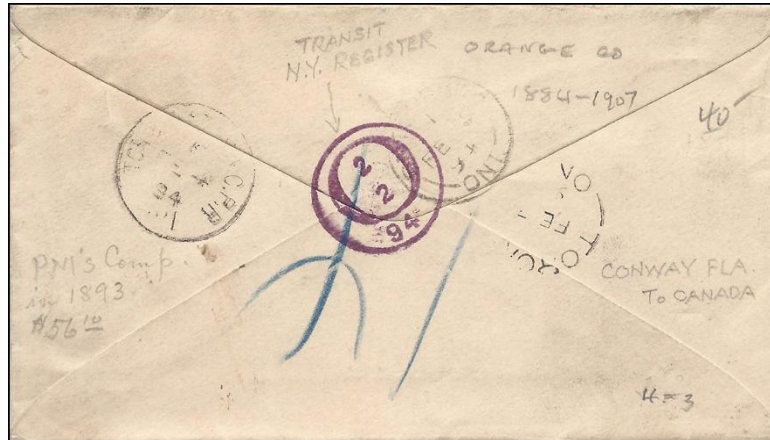


Citronelle Fla. 12.01.1896, on reverse examiner's handstamp O. (Courtesy of Deane Briggs)

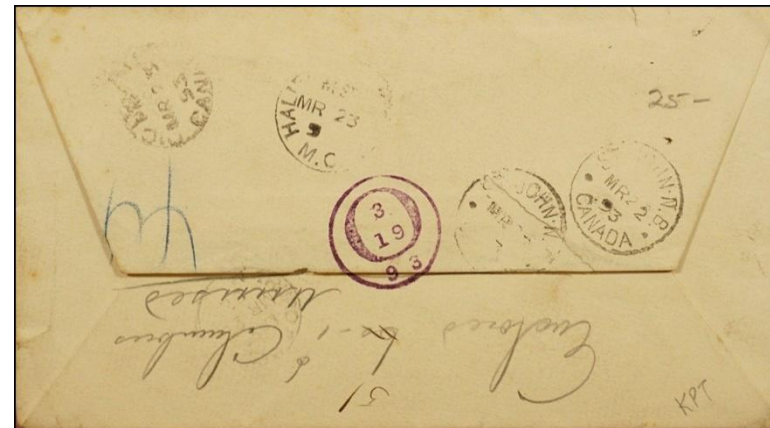


Coconut Grove Fla. 08.27.1893, on reverse examiner's handstamp O. (Courtesy of Deane Briggs)

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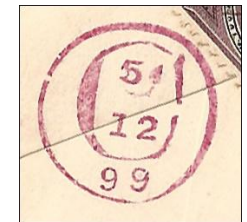
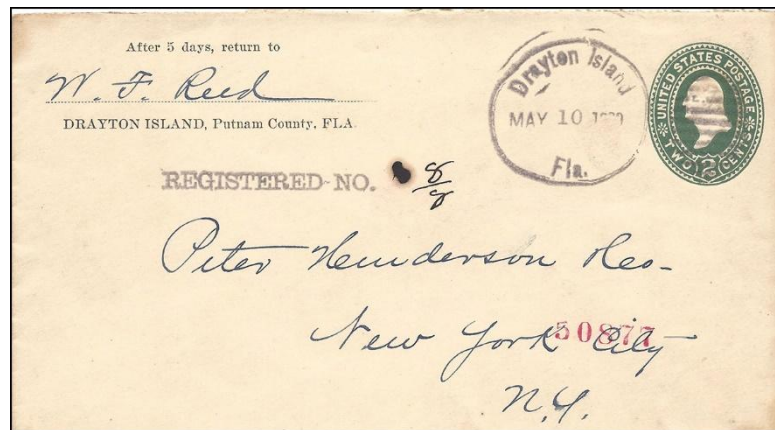


Conway Fla. 01.26.1894. on reverse examiner's handstamp O. (Courtesy of Deane Briggs)

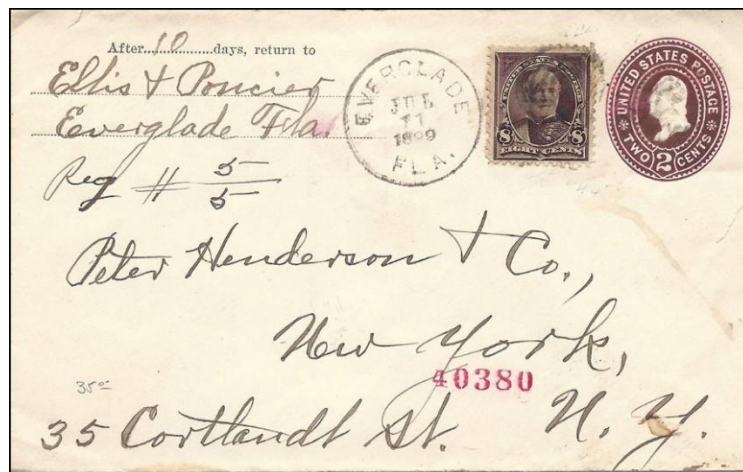

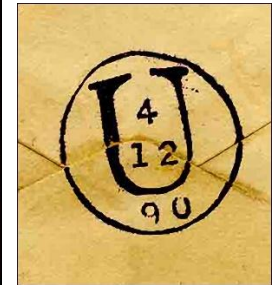

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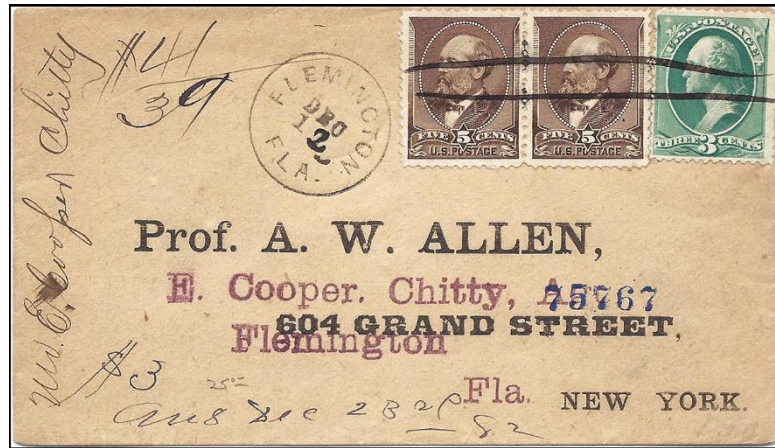


Evinston Fla. 04.09.1890 Manuscript, on reserve examiner's handstamp **U**. (Courtesy of Phil Eschbach)

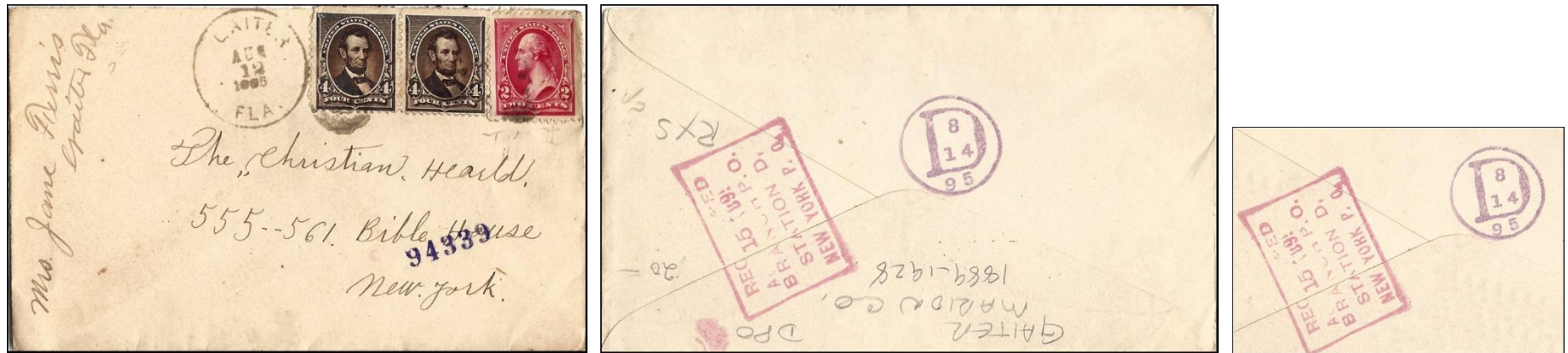

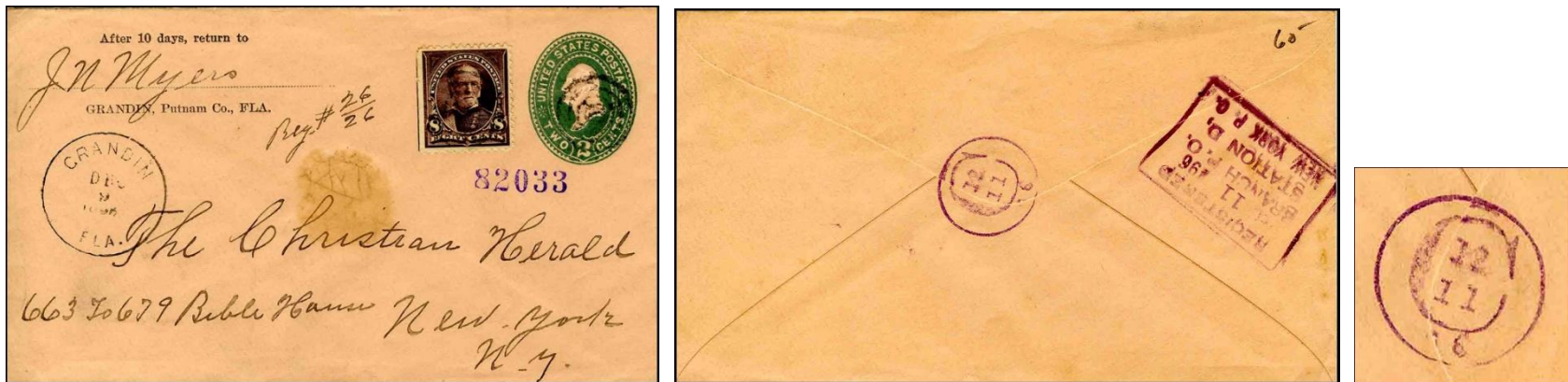


Gainesboro Fla, 12.17.1895, on reverse examiner's handstamp U. (Courtesy of Deane Briggs)

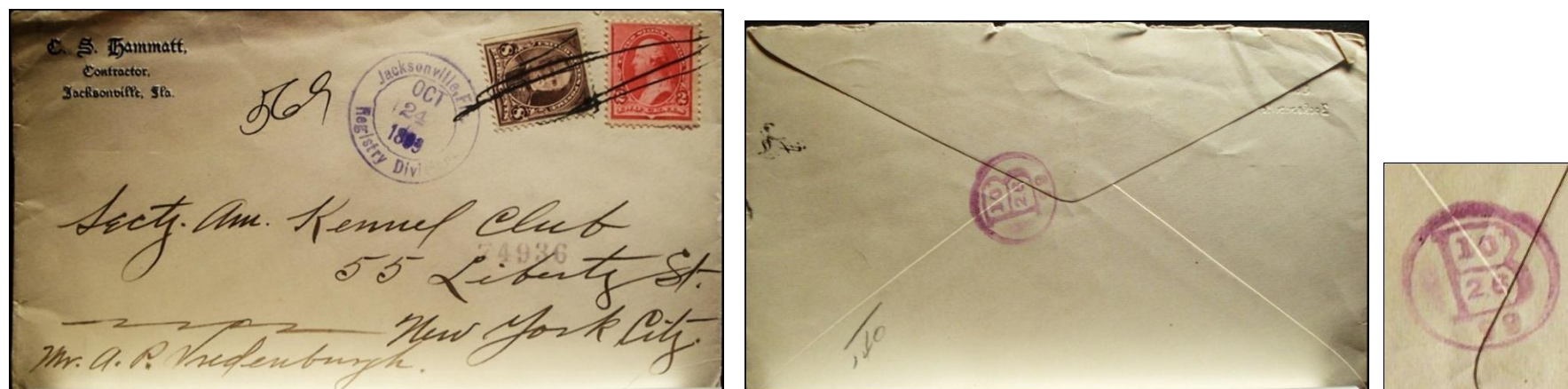

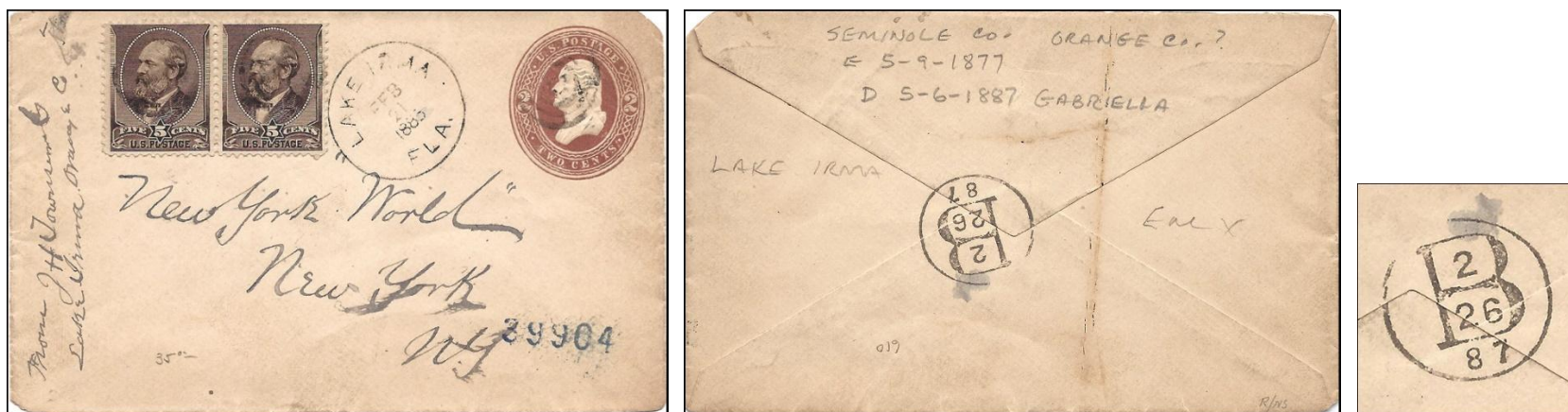


Grandin Fla., 12.09.1896, on reverse examiner's handstamp C. (Courtesy of Phil Eschbach)

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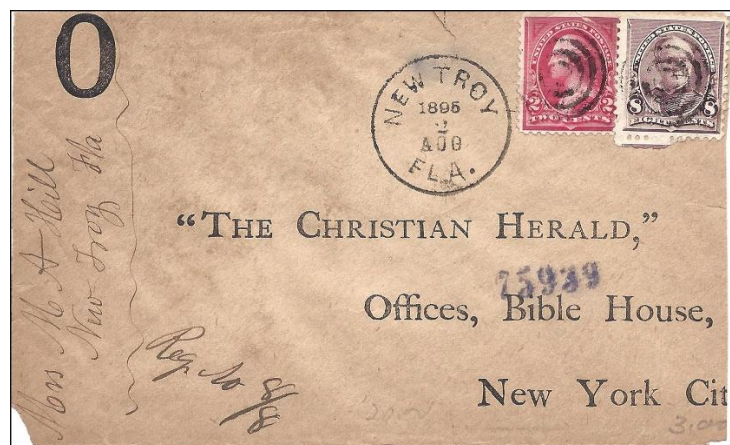

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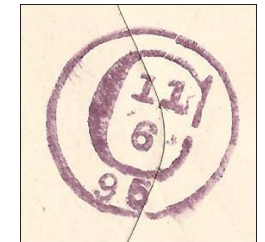
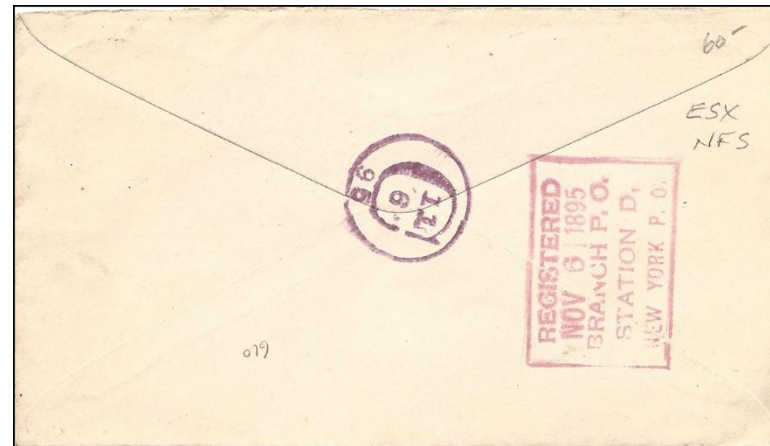
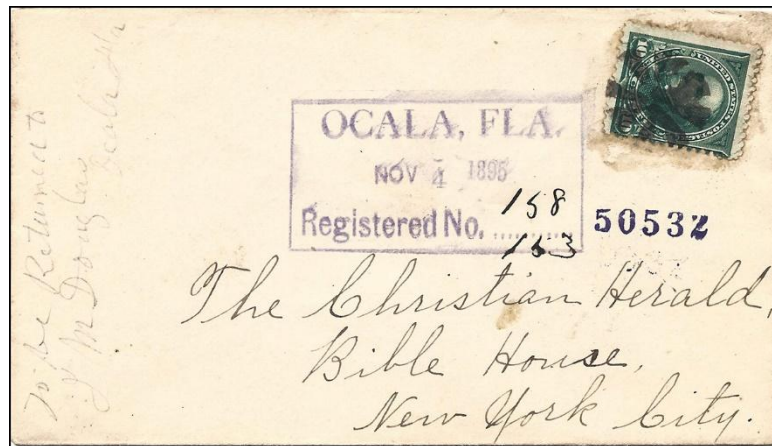


New Troy Fla., 08.02.1895, Date slug inverted, on reverse examiner's handstamp **B**. (Courtesy of Deane Briggs)

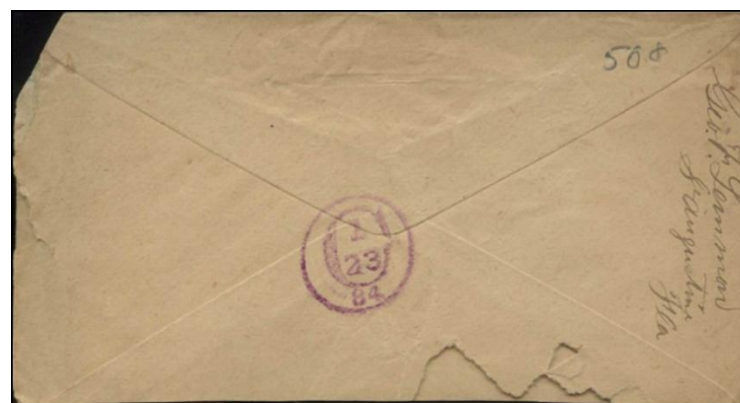

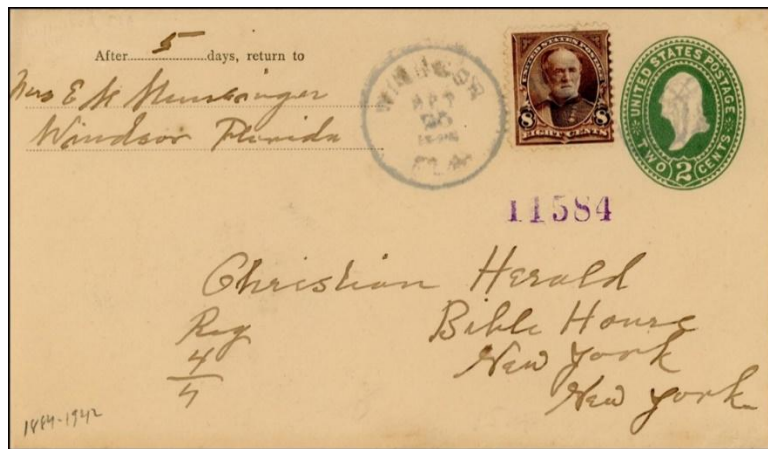


Valrico Fla., 09.08.1895, on reverse examiner's handstamp D. (Courtesy of Deane Briggs)

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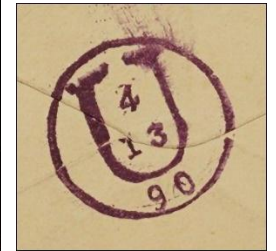


West Lake Fla., 12.01.1898 on reverse Branch PO Station D and examiner's handstamp U. (Courtesy of Deane Briggs)



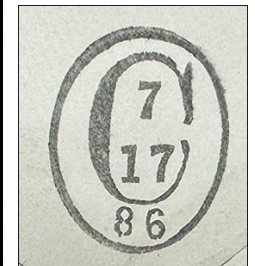
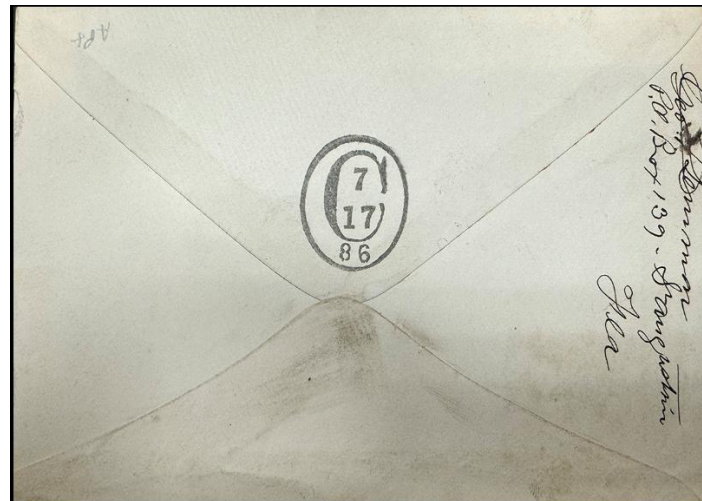
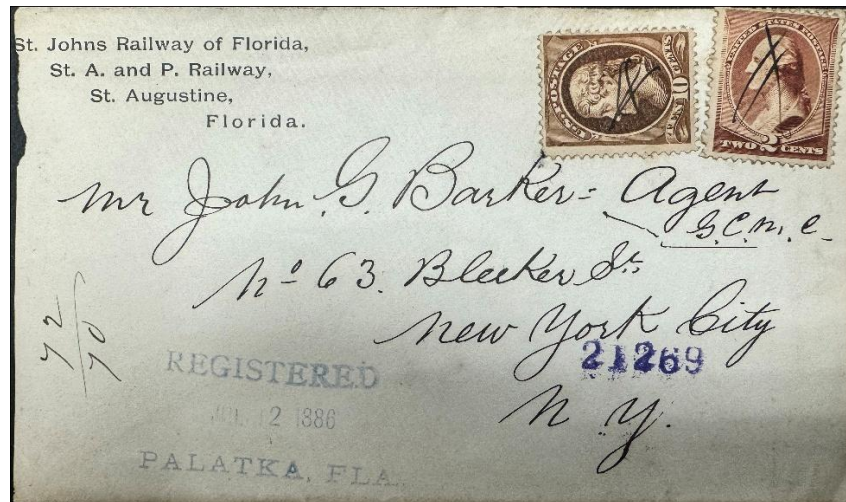

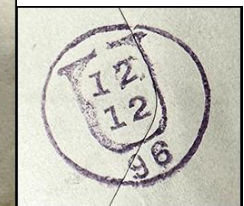
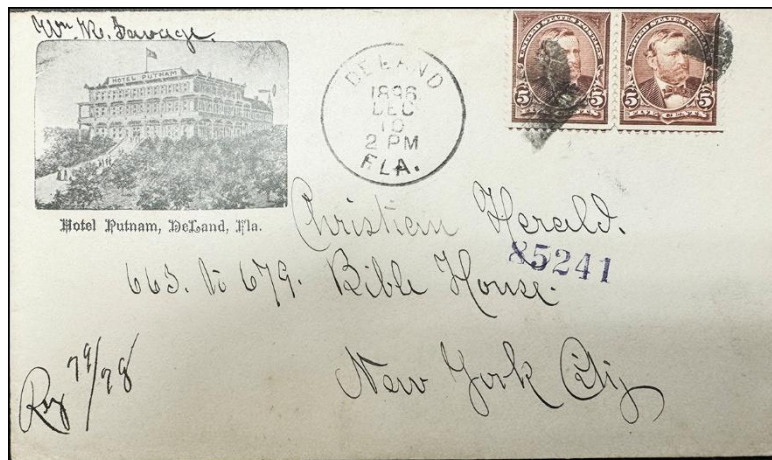


Palatka, Fla. 07.02.1886, on reverse examiner's handstamp C.
